Bedford's Street Angels are appealing for more volunteers as services will soon be extending weekend patrols to Friday as well as Saturday. Street Angels volunteers are a reassuring presence on the streets of Bedford. They help members of the public who have drunk too much and help keep them safe, which allows the Police to tackle serious incidents where their presence is required.

As with Saturday, Friday patrols will run from 10.00pm – 3.00am as mixed gender teams. All new volunteers will be required to complete an application and undertake an enhanced CRB check.

Gill Anderson, Principal Licensing Officer, Bedford Borough Council said “Following the tragic death of Robert Gill we were all made aware that people visiting our pubs and clubs could become separated from their friends and be extremely vulnerable. Initially when I heard about the plan I was very sceptical and thought it was about converting people. How wrong was I, the angels offer that additional safe guard and I take my hat off to them. Would any of us give up our free time to do what they do? At some point all of us have someone we love and care about in the pubs and clubs in Town and this additional safe guard is a fantastic achievement”
